Burning Permits during Fire Prohibition.

All fire breaks must be in place and completed by the 31st of July of every year, or if stipulated otherwise through the official communication channels of the Letaba Fire Protection Association.

Agriculture sectors, Sawmills and Conservation, take note of 1.3.2 of the LFPA Rules below:

1.3.2 Burning Permits – No Burning Period

Commercial agriculture farms and Sawmills may be given special burning permits to do controlled burning during the **NO Burning Period** which runs from 01 August to 30 October of each year, or as otherwise informed by the LFPA.

These permits must be applied for at least one week in advance of the planned burn and the permits will only be issued pending a visit by the LFPA's Fire Manager to ensure that the burn site is safe and that it holds no threat to any neighbouring properties. This burning permit will also be highly depended on the weather in the week building up to the burn and also the weather in the week after the burn.

Should any changes occur with regards to the safety of the burn the LFPA will cancel the burning permit and no burning may happen on the planned date. Non LFPA members will also be granted the opportunity to obtain a special burning permit but Non LFPA members will pay a fee for this permit as determined by the LFPA.

The LFPA Operations Centre must be informed about the burning at least one hour before the actual start of the burning operation in order for LFPA to inform the other landowners in the area.

Note: Undermining / disobeying this rule set forth by the Letaba FPA could result in a legal warning and / or fine!

Please contact the Letaba FPA regarding burning permits as stated above during the Fire Prohibition period should you request one, or for any other information you may require!
